

Monthly Full Moon Meaning

Continuing the series, this month's full moon is called the Flower Moon. Owing to when many wildflowers bloom across North America. The name is attributed to Native American tribes, particularly the Algonquin people who ranged from the Rocky Mountains to the Atlantic Ocean and from Canada to the Carolinas. Native American people traditionally associated the moon with the seasonal changes observed in nature.

Seasonally this moon marks the peak of spring when numerous wildflowers burst into bloom. Historically, the name Flower Moon was used by various cultures and was documented by early European settlers in North America.
