

Monthly Full Moon Meaning

Brothers, the November full moon is called the Beaver Moon. Again, the name of the full moon comes from a variety of sources, notably Native American, Colonial America and European folklore. This moon marks the time for beavers to prepare for winter with the building of dams and storing food. Also, it is the traditional time for the trapping of beavers which were valued for their pelts. This moon has two symbolisms. First, it is a time of intense effort, in preparation for winter and the closing down of activities. Second, is the importance of slowing down and heading indoors to reflect on the work completed during the year. Spiritually, the Beaver moon brings the two symbolisms together. It is seen as a time for completing tasks and preparing for new beginnings after a period of focused effort.
